B Results using TOP repression in continuous form

We show here results replicating the local-level analyses but using the main independent variable, authoritarian repression, measured in continuous form, namely, as the logged number of sentenced per 1,000 inhabitants in 1960.

Table A2 replicates the analyses in the main text where we explore the effect of all authoritarian repression on the formation of voluntary associations during the democratic period. Table A3 repeats these analyses but using as our main independent variable a measure of repression of violent activities, while Table A4 does the same but focusing on repression of non-violent activities.

D Wartime violence and later TOP repression

In this section we discuss the problem of endogeneity in the geographical distribution of Francoist repression. In particular, one concern is that the same municipalities that suffered repression during the authoritarian regime, as measured by the TOP data, also suffered higher rates of wartime violence or were more leftist immediately before the war and the Francoist regime. Table A9 shows the results of a model where we use a binary measure of repression during the Francoist regime (between 1963 and 1976) and, as independent variables, we include the change in population between 1930 and 1960, the intensity of wartime violence against civilians by nationalist (Francoist) forces, and leftist support in 1936. We also control for population in 1960. We run separate models for three versions of the dependent variable, following the analyses in the main text: all repression, repression of violence activities, and repression of non-violent activities. Table ?? repeats these models but using a continuous version of the TOP dependent variable, again distinguishing between all repression, repression of violence activities, and repression of non-violent activities.

Results show that authoritarian repression was independent from wartime and prewar dynamics. If anything, there is a positive effect of prewar leftist support, but it is only significant at the 90% level. Overall, repression in the 1960s and 1970s was mainly driven by contemporary population.

E Results on turnout

In this section, we include results using our alternative measure of local political participation: turnout. Using the official data published by the Spanish Ministry of Interior,² we calculate municipality-level turnout in all local elections, held every four years, since 1979. The models then follow the local-level analyses in the main text: we use the same repression measures as independent variables, the same control variables, and province fixed effects.

Table A10 shows the results of the models on turnout in local elections using the general measure of Francoist repression, which includes all instances of repression. Table A11 repeats the same models but including the measure of repression of violent activities, while Table A12 does the same with the measure of repression of non-violent activities. Figure A1 summarizes the results.




Figure A1: Coefficient plots for local election turnout models




Figure A2: Coefficient plot for cohort-effect (born before 1955) models




Figure A3: Coefficient plot for cohort-effect (born before 1945) models

H Additional analyses using CIS 2760

In this section, we show additional results using a 2008 survey on the memories of the Spanish Civil War and the Francoist regime fielded in 2008 by the Centro de Investigaciones Sociológicas (CIS) (Aguilar et al., 2011). We run two sets of logit regressions on two binary outcomes that measure the self-perceived importance of participating in politics. We recode both outcome variables from an original 3-point scale question asking the respondent whether she agrees, neither agrees nor disagrees, or disagrees with a series of statements. The first outcome indicates whether individuals agree with the statement 'For democracy to work better, it is important to participate in politics.' The second outcome indicates whether individuals disagree with the statement 'It is better not to get involved in politics.'

As independent variables, we use four indicators of self-reported victimization. First, whether the respondent was victimized first-hand during the Francoist regime, including being detained, imprisoned, expelled from her job, fined, or forced to leave Spain. This question was only presented to individuals who were above 45 years old at the time of the survey. Second, we include another variable measuring whether any of the events above, additionally including being executed, occurred to any member of the respondent's family or close friend. Finally, we use two variables indicating that the respondent said that a member of her family/close friend was victimized during the Spanish Civil War (1936–1939) by the Republican or the Nationalist side, respectively. Civil war victimization includes experiences such as being killed in combat, in a bombardment, being executed, disappeared, or condemned to death (among other, less intense forms of victimization).

Following Aguilar et al. (2011) and Balcells (2012), all models control for age, gender, interest in politics, education level, religiosity, whether the respondent indicates that her family spoke about politics at home when they were growing up, and the size of the municipality.

We show the results in Table A15 and Table A16. In both tables, the first two columns only includes respondents who were above 45 years old at the time of the survey, while the last two columns use the full sample. In the latter case, the variable indicating per-

sonal (as in first-hand) victimization during the Francoist regime is coded as 0 for anyone who was 45 or younger.

We find in both cases, but most clearly for the outcome on the importance of political participation for the functioning of democracy (Table A15), that while family victimization during the Spanish Civil War increases the self-perceived importance of political participation, victimization during the Francoist regime has no effect or a negative one. These results suggest that authoritarian repression, at least in the context of Spain, is probably substantially different from wartime/immediate postwar victimization.
